Our extensive facilities, amenities and services are available for the enjoyment of all residents.

The peaceful surroundings of our estate offer accessible woodland, lakeside walks and glorious gardens right on the doorstep. There are also community allotments, a ceramic garden, chicken run, bird hide and wildlife wetland area. The pavilion and sports recreation area include a boules pitch, a full size outdoor bowls green and small golf themed area including putting green.

Middleton Hall's Health & Wellbeing Centre features a gym, fitness studio, swimming pool, jacuzzi, and hair salon, along with therapy rooms for beauty treatments and chiropody. Pilates, yoga, and physiotherapy sessions are also available to book.

Our popular Orangery Bistro is open daily, and the elegant surroundings of the Middleton Hall Restaurant provide the backdrop for events and themed dining evenings.

A busy and varied schedule of activities includes creative classes in our art studio, visiting musicians and entertainers, and indoor sports and fun fitness sessions. Residents also enjoy our musical-themed activities such as 'Singing for the Soul' and music appreciation groups and can join regular trips to local places of interest.

OUR ACCOMMODATION

MIDDLETON GARDENS RESIDENTIAL CARE

Middleton Gardens offers modern, spacious living with 22 en-suite bedrooms, some with private patio doors opening onto the gardens. It is perfect for those who enjoy companionship but need some support with personal care and mobility.

MIDDLETON COURT RESIDENTIAL CARE

Middleton Court offers tailored residential care for those needing more complex support, including neurological conditions, stroke recovery, or assistance with mobility.

It is ideal for those who need a little more help day-to-day, in a supportive and compassionate environment.











MIDDLETON OAKS SUPPORTED LIVING

The three supported households in Middleton Oaks provide a home from home environment offering small group living. They are designed to allow people who may need some prompts and encouragement to live as independently as possible. Often those who benefit are living with dementia.

Eight people live in each of the innovative households which are based on a Dutch model to create a more home-like, personal experience. Residents often need a higher level of practical, nurturing support and everyone is accepted on their own terms. The houses are open door facilities so people can lead as independent a life as possible and enjoy the estate's facilities and grounds in a way we assess and agree is as safe as possible.

MIDDLETON GROVE APARTMENTS WITH CARE AND SUPPORT

Middleton Grove offers stylish apartments for those who value independence but would benefit from living in a small friendly community offering care, support, security and companionship.

The well-appointed apartments, including some in the Georgian wing, feature a sitting room, bedroom, accessible bathroom, and kitchen area equipped for independent living. Flexible service options that include housekeeping, laundry, and transport are available, with optional care support if needed.
